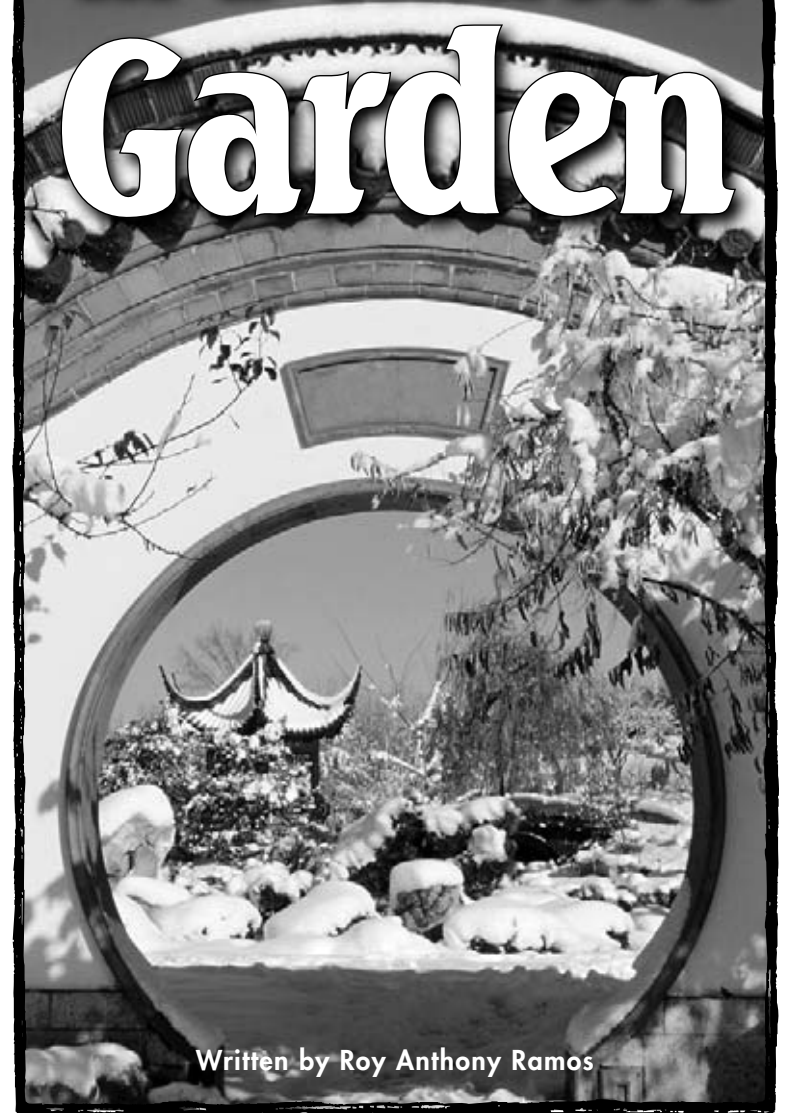

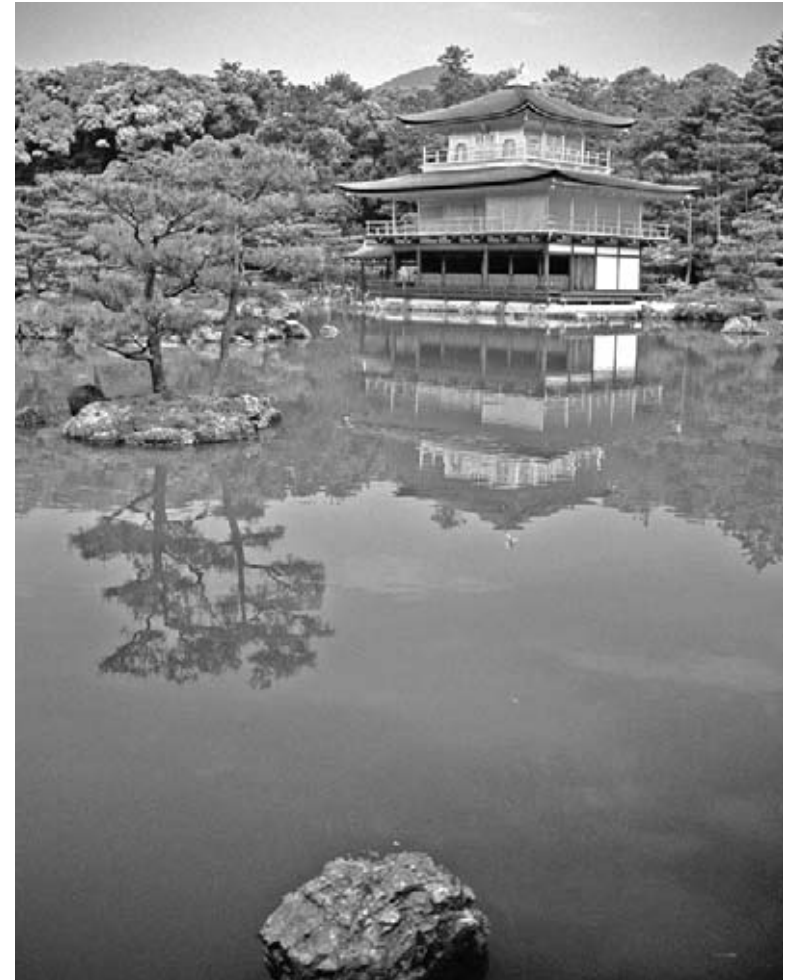

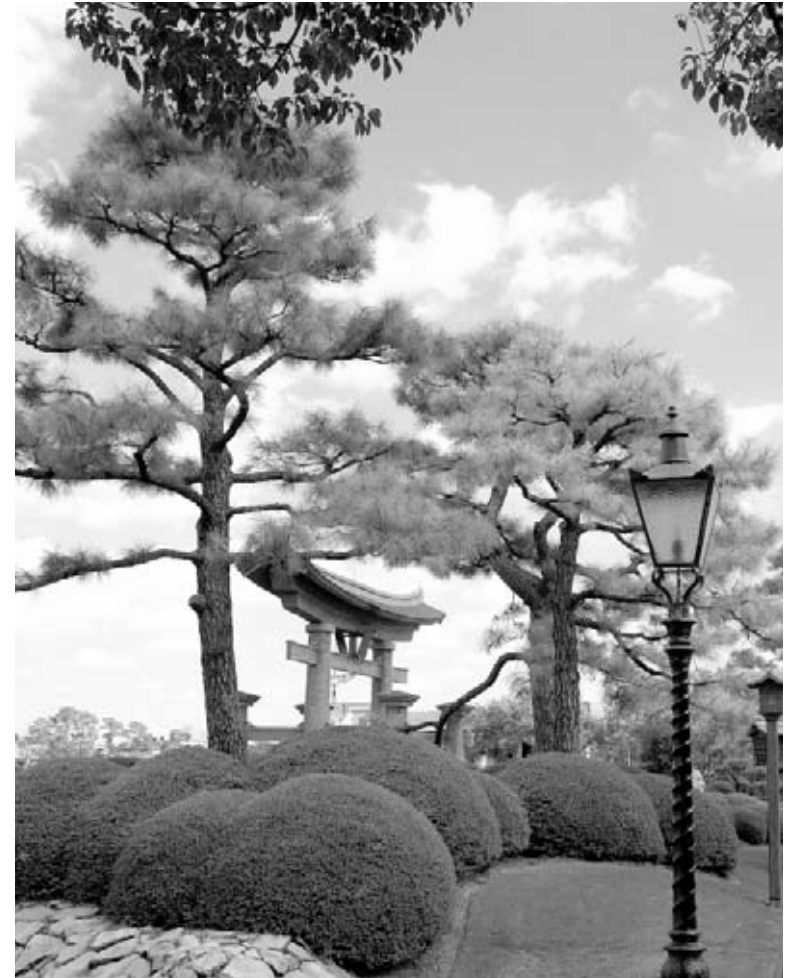


I see a huge rock.

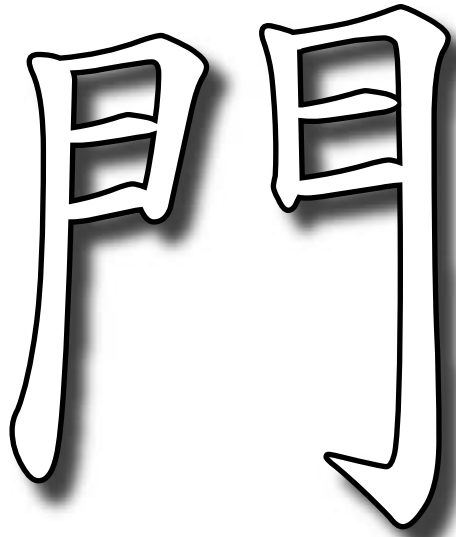


I see trees.
